#### **PERCY ESTATE FLOODING:** 65. Minutes from 24.02.25 recommendation is to abandon the lesser site and install phased drainage, next step = quotes for lesser site and how this will be phased to go to Finance and Policy committee meeting 9<sup>th</sup> June or 14<sup>th</sup> August. Options for how the drainage can be phased and costed to be explored ahead of the F&P meetings. Seeking funding from other sources was discussed. Mr P Borrill to work with the ATC to bring this to the appropriate F&P meeting. **Review Allotments rules and regulations** 66. Allotment rules and regulations be reviewed for 2025. Question was asked about the use of hose pipes from a bath which has collected rainwater and should this be allowed. Consideration to be given to different mobility levels of the plot holders. Agreed to redraft item 5.17 "Water" in the Rules and regulations to reflect that and bring to the next meeting for approval. ATC to action **PUMPKINS** 67. Halloween week in half term, w/c 27<sup>th</sup> October 2025 various events in the town. Pumpkin related events such as largest pumpkin grown on the allotments, seeds can be provided for this for allotment holders for May planting. There was much interest in this and suggestions of different categories for a pumpkin competition in October such as biggest or ugliest. Allotment reps to contact the ATC for seeds.
