- 1. Welcome given by Cllr T Morris Mayor of Warwick
- 2. Prayers read by Jane Sault.
- **3. Apologies:** Cllr J Darcy & Cllr Ms M Noone gave their apologies it was resolved to accept.
- 4. Declarations of Interest: None
- **5.** Confirmation of minutes from the Council Meeting 11th March 2021 it was resolved to accept the minutes as a true reflection of the meeting.
