ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D4219 MASEFIELD AVENUE, WARWICK AND
TEMPORARY ONE WAY TRAFFIC FLOW MASEFIELD AVENUE WARWICK.**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D4219 Masefield Avenue, Warwick, between its junction with Kipling Ave/Longfellow Ave and Shelley Avenue, to vehicular traffic to safely facilitate footway reconstruction works.

A One-Way traffic flow will be imposed from the Shakespeare Ave roundabout towards Kipling Ave/Longfellow Ave junction. The closure & restrictions are required 9.30-15.30 weekdays only.

The Order will commence on 22 July 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 13 August 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Shelley Avenue, Longfellow Avenue, Kipling Avenue, Tennyson Avenue and Shakespeare Avenue.
