ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PACKMORE STREET, WARWICK

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Packmore Street, Warwick to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for the installation of a boundary box and meter.

The Order will commence on 19 September 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 September 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Packmore Street, Roe Close, Paradise Street, Lakin Road (and vice versa).
