The development results in harm to the character and appearance of the area and conflicts with Policy BE1 of the Warwick District Local Plan (2017) which seeks to ensure development positively contributes to the character and quality of the environment through good layout and design with particular regard to harmonising with or enhancing the existing settlement.
		Given the recent Huddison Close appeal refusal by the Inspector who determined it on its own merits and on the basis of the evidence before him and he found the loss of the greenspace had a harmful effect on the character and appearance of the area. He acknowledged that similar fencing had been constructed in the nearby area, however, its existence did not justify further harm.
