Report for the year 2018

Both of the apartments were re-decorated and, after interviewing several applicants, two new ladies took up residence, and are very happy in their new homes. All nine properties are in good order and are subject to regular checks.

Tibbitts Court once again took part in Warwick in Bloom and were disappointed that they didn't retain the cup this year! However, we understand that they are planning to enter again in 2019 and are hoping to get their hands on the trophy once more.

Towards the end of the year we were notified that the Almshouse Association would be holding a seminar for Clerks and new Trustees at the Lord Leycester Hospital in spring 2019 and have asked that one or two Trustees of Warwick United Charity be available to show the delegates (expected to number approximately 60) round the properties during the day. This visit will be reported on next year.
